Easy Cozy Scarf

A simple, timeless scarf for everyday warmth.

This easy scarf pattern is perfect for beginners and experienced knitters alike. With simple stitches and a beautiful, cozy texture, it's a relaxing and rewarding project. Wrap yourself in the warmth and comfort of handmade — and enjoy our creations.

Specifications & Materials

- **Skill Level:** Beginner (with guidance) to Advanced
- **Size:** Approximately 180 cm long x 20 cm wide (can be made shorter or longer as desired)
- **Yarn:** 8-ply / DK / Worsted weight yarn (approx. 200g)
- **Needles:** 4.00 mm – 5.00 mm straight or circular needles
- **Gauge:** 18 stitches and 24 rows = 10 cm in garter stitch
- **Notions:** Tapestry needle, scissors



Step-by-Step Instructions

1 Cast On

Using your chosen needles, cast on 28 stitches (or any number you prefer, keeping it a multiple of 2).

2 Work the Scarf

Knit every row (garter stitch) until your scarf measures your desired length. This simple stitch creates a lovely, soft and textured fabric.

3 Bind Off

When your scarf is the right length, bind off loosely in knit stitch. Cut your yarn, leaving a long tail (approx. 20 cm).



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Step-by-Step Instructions (continued)

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Finishing

Thread the yarn tail onto a tapestry needle. Weave in the ends neatly, making sure they are secure. Give your scarf a gentle block if needed, by lightly misting with water and laying flat until dry.



Helpful Tip

For a longer or wider scarf, simply cast on more stitches or work for more rows. This pattern is easy to adjust to your preferred size.
